Subject: Building Plans and Survey

Dear NorthPoint Church Family,

Pastor Al emphasized in a recent sermon that our Church is not a building... it is us! We thank God for his leadership and ability to help us focus on “people, not property and finances”. In that spirit, your leadership team at NorthPoint seeks to help answer a question that we get asked frequently... when are we going to get started on the building? The current answer is... it depends. It depends on where the building fits into our priorities as individuals and a church family.

Currently, nine families at NorthPoint are giving regularly to the Land/Building fund. This, along with some large one-time gifts, has allowed us to pay off \$329,000 of the \$729,000 for the combined properties and house. This leaves us with \$400,000 of remaining debt. The continued contribution of the nine families allows us to slowly but steadily pay down the remaining debt while meeting our monthly operating, principal, and interest expenses. However, without more participation in the Land/Building fund from others, it could be **at least 5 years** before we are in a position to begin building. Building sooner rather than later will require broader participation. Should we be seeking broader participation in the Land/Building fund at this time? Is building sooner rather than later important?

The leadership team will share the results of the survey, answer questions, and discuss alternatives on how to proceed. **This meeting will occur at 10:00 a.m. (immediately following the 9:00 a.m. service) on Sunday, June 3rd.** With the benefit of knowing what’s important and possible, we can move in unity towards a common goal.
